How has illegal art become rooted here? Well, some talented and convincing artists, along with the help of dedicated associations and even the municipal authorities have developed a trend!

We'll then head to the northern part of the arrondissement towards the Seine River. There you'll witness the differences between vintage and neo Street Art and its evolution in the last 4 decades. What used to be a residential district with buildings built in the 70's became a modern Street Art wonderland with its enormous frescoes that enlighten the urban landscape.
